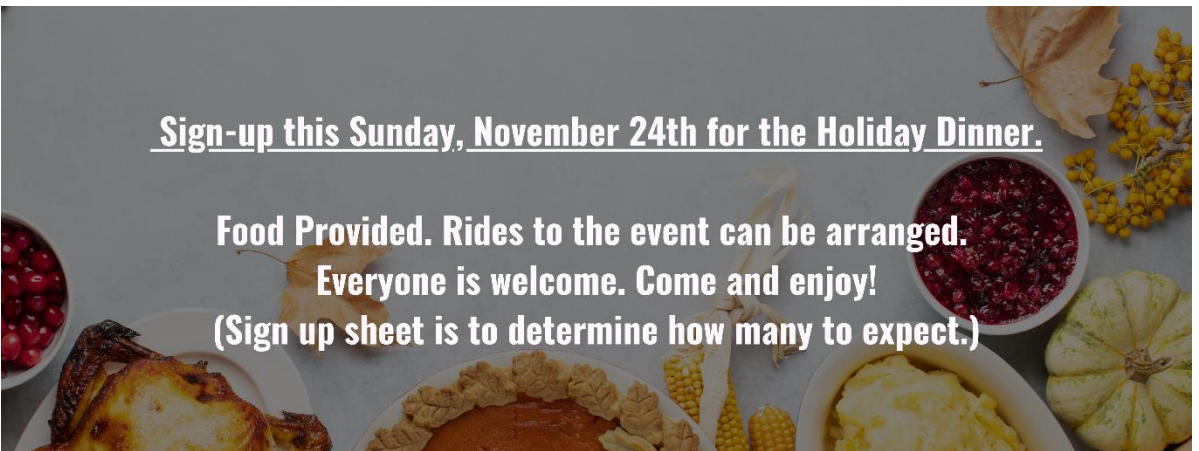
The Christmas tree you see every year in the Nartex is the Deacons tree. The tree we have now was purchased with Memorial funds in memory of Neva Jackson.
